He has been designing for more than twenty-five years, and throughout his career his designs have remained contemporary and relevant. Reinvention and a youthful approach lie at the heart of his creative journey and ensures that this spirit pervades all his creations.

Design for him is less of a profession and more of an all-encompassing lifestyle, an approach to the everyday, which through observation and interpretation weaves its way into new creations. Keeping the mind and the eye open allows for a free flow of creativity and inspiration, thereby seeing things others might not.

Over the years, Damian has acquired a wealth of material and manufacturing knowledge, from industrial to craft, which serves him and his clients well in deciding how to proceed with any given project. His clients include Delvaux, Hermès, Louis Vuitton, Rosenthal and Vista Alegre.

He has won many awards including the Braun Prize, Dutch Design Prize and Red Dot Award. His work has also been exhibited in many museums around the world (Boijmans van Beuningen, Fondation EDF, Holon Design Museum, MoMA and the V&A).
